Weekly Schedule:

Monday: The **EPGC Junior Golf** program is conducted on Monday mornings beginning on June 17 and the course will be closed during camp times (excluding outings). The Golf Course **hosts outings** every Monday most of the summer and will work in conjunction with Junior Golf. May-August, the **EPGC Men's League** has priority on either tee #1 or #10 at 5:00 p.m. alternating nines each week.

Tuesday: EPGC Ladies League Play Day – May-September, #1 tee will be reserved for morning EPGC 18-hole Ladies League play from 7:30 – 10:00 a.m. From May-August, tee #1 is reserved for the EPGC 9-hole Ladies of the Evening (LOTE) league play from 3:00 – 5:30 p.m. (NOTE: LOTE starts on the back none on the last Tuesday of each month.)

Wednesday: EPGC Couples League – May-September, tee #1 is reserved for morning EPGC couples play until 11:00 a.m.

Thursday: EPGC Men's Play Day - May-September, tee #1 is reserved from 10:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. for men's play.

Friday: Open play. Special club events or small group outings may be held.

Saturday: Permanent tee times are in effect in the mornings from May - September. Special club events or small group outings may be held once a month.

Sunday: MEMBERS ONLY and their guests can play on Sundays and Holidays. Permanent tee times are in effect from May-September.

NOTE: Play may be restricted at times to accommodate scheduled golf outings. Tee times are highly recommended.

The "rough" mower is back out doing its job. The clover will be sprayed again now that the rain has slowed down and June tends to be a drier month. It is being cut at the same height; it is just thicker.

The greens are firm and fast. But will slow down once we zero in on the irrigation. There is a lot of bad, exposed wiring, especially at the bridges. This is being replaced and encased as time allows. The grounds crew appreciates your patience as we work through all these issues.
