

EPGC 18-Hole Ladies League

Fall Meeting Minutes – December 9, 2025

President Joyce Steinman called the meeting to order after lunch on Dec 9, 2025.

Old Business:

- Joyce thanked the greeters that volunteered to check us in and handled the weekly “quarter box” prizes.
- She then recapped some of the items we changed this season:
 - The point system and payout at the end of season worked well – keep!
 - Weekly results were emailed and posted on the website and on the new bulletin board in the ladies room – keep!
 - She isn’t sure if we will be keeping Golf Genius or not and will have to check with the pro next spring. Remember to always double check your scorecard vs GG if we do!
- The treasurer report was read by treasurer Karen Weiland and is include at the end of these minutes. Donna Moritz moved to accept them and Tamara Harvell seconded the motion.
- Patty Bishop recapped 2025 Spring Meeting minutes. Some discussion about those topics arose, but will be documented in the “new business” section below.
- League officers will be the same in 2026: President - Joyce Steinman, Treasurer – Karen Weiland, and Secretary – Patty Bishop.

New Business:

- **Interclub** - Beth Sennett will remain as our interclub representative for 18 hole league and will also assume those duties for the 9-hole league. Thank you Beth!!
- **Hole in One fund** - Linda Messer reported on the Hole-in-One fund: We took in over \$5000, had 4 hole-in-1’s, leaving over \$3700 remaining. Suggestions were made as to what could be purchased with those funds such as garbage cans or ball washers at the ladies tees. We could also use a 2nd bulletin board in the ladies’ room. Nothing was decided on during this meeting. We thought it would be good to discuss with the course as well as our league.
- **Golf Genius next year?** - Dustin, the golf pro, had mentioned he had a program he liked better than Golf Genius, so we will wait to see what he wants to use next season.
- **Opening Day** will be **Tuesday, April 21!** We will have a meeting, lunch, followed by a 9-hole scramble (weather permitting).
- **1st Full league morning** – will be **April 28**, which also happens to be **Donna Shad’s 90th birthday**. Let’s not forget that special day!!
- **Cart fees** - Due to changes made by the club, non-cart owners will now have to pay a cart fee to EPGC. Therefore we will eliminate our \$6 league cart fee that we charged to ride with a cart owner. This will impact our league income as the \$6 used to help cover league costs.
- **Dues** – Dues will increase **from \$20 to \$25** next season.
- **Point Payout** - This year’s point payout (2025) was \$432, which is \$24/week.
- **Course Member?** - We discussed if you should be a course member to join the league and agreed that YES, you must be a member of EPGC to join the 18-hole ladies league.

- **Guests?** – We agreed that yes, we will allow league members to bring a guest. They will need to pay green & cart fees, if applicable. They may play in the weekly quarter game if desired, but may not compete for the weekly points (low gross, net, putts, POD).
- **League growth** – we would like to see this league grow and discussed possible ways to help with this. 1) **invite club members to play!** We will put up a sign inviting club ladies to play if they'd like to try it out. We discussed keeping track of the number of times a guest plays but opted against keeping track as we see this as an opportunity to gain future members. 2) Nancy Wilsey offered to get a list of new EPGC lady members and call to **invite new club members** to join our league. Thank you Nancy!
- **No invitational** – we didn't have an invitational this year and instead did a league fun event including a 50/50 drawing and a "guess the baby picture" game. Thanks to Joyce for the fun ideas! We don't plan to have an invitation in 2026.
- **League Rule changes/reminders!**
 - For 2025 we had the **Super senior tee options** to tee off across the creeks on holes 7, 12, and 16 for those aged 75 and over. Those over 80 could tee off at the front of each tee box. It was a little confusing to have different ages for the two "super senior tee" options, so we changed this rule to use the **age of 75 for BOTH** super senior tee options in 2026.
 - **Out of Bounds ball** – as a local rule for our league, beginning in 2026, we will allow the golfer to take 2 strokes and bring the ball to the **middle of the fairway** (instead of just 2 club lengths) across from where the ball crossed the out of bounds line. Remember to add 2 strokes from this point (so hitting 4 if you hit out of bounds off the tee).
 - **24" Gimme putts** will continue as last year. Use a putter marked with 24" to measure and you may pick up and add 1 stroke. If you opt out of the 24" gimme local rule for this league, then putt out all putts on all holes. You can still be in the low putts weekly game either way.
 - We play **winter rules**. Play the ball up in the fairway and rough, but leave as-is in a hazard.
- **Prize point payout**– Nancy Beckman asked a question about the weekly prize points and if you can win multiple points in a given week. After much discussion, we voted on and approved the following: *you cannot win both low gross and low net and the max points you can win in a given week is 2*. These points are by flight.
